Change to bulk verge collection dates

The next bulk verge collections have been moved from October to July to avoid potential impact on the November Anzac Albany commemorative period.

Verge collections are for residential properties with a wheelie bin service only and will begin Monday July 14. There will be no verge collection in October.

Unwanted items must be on the kerbside the weekend before collection is scheduled and will be collected within 5-10 working days of the collection zone start date.

Items should be in three piles: Junk, Metal & E-Waste. Cooperation will ensure items are removed in a timely fashion.

For details on what can and cannot be collected and collection dates for the four different zones, please refer to the flyer on the City of Albany website.

Residents who have restricted verge access are requested to contact Cleanaway for advice.

Residents are also requested to ensure that items do not obstruct footpaths, essential services or line of sight for pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles.

Trees, power poles, walls, street signs, sprinklers or water meters may be damaged by collection machinery if items are placed in close proximity.
