Local parks enhancement draft plans open for public comment

The City of Albany wishes to hear from residents, community groups and stakeholders as it seeks to improve Cull Park and Baltic Ridge Park.

Through the City of Albany's community engagement, the City invited residents to contribute to the planning of parks in their local area earlier this year.

Draft plans of both Cull Park and Baltic Ridge Park have been developed based on community feedback collected during May 2014.

Over 1000 comments were received through the drop-in sessions, surveys and written submissions to inform the draft plans.

The City of Albany is inviting more submissions concerning the Draft Cull Park Improvement Plan and the Draft Baltic Ridge Development Plan.

The plans are available for viewing at the City's North Road office and on the City of Albany website.

Submissions should be in writing and lodged no later than August 15 at 5pm.

The City is committed to engaging with the community about the improvements to Cull Park and Baltic Ridge Park.
