YEY! Tenth anniversary of Great Southern Noongar Exhibition

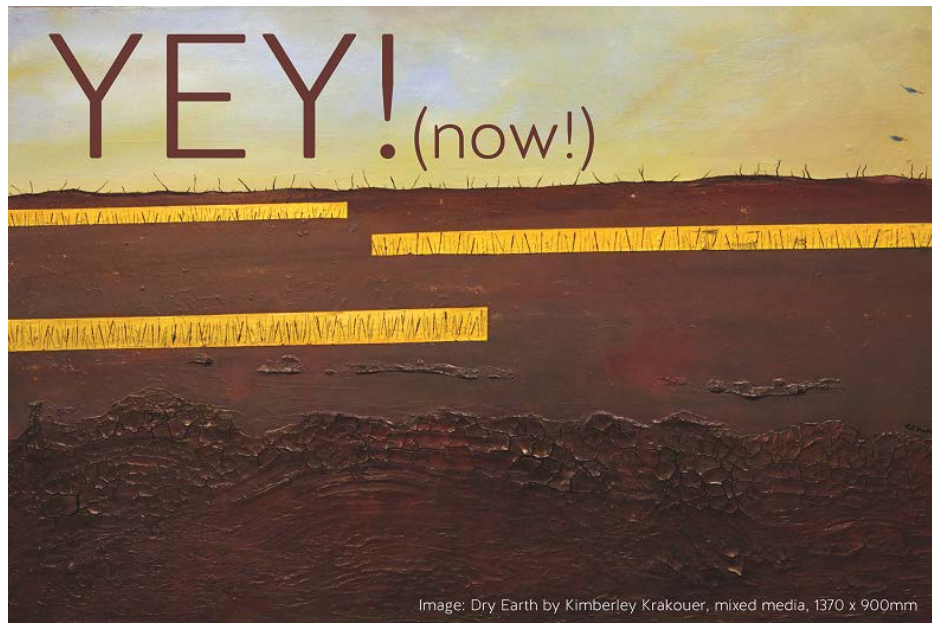


Image: Dry Earth by Kimberley Krakouer, mixed media, 1370 x 900mm

10th Annual Great Southern Noongar Exhibition

The tenth anniversary of the Vancouver Arts Centre's Great Southern Noongar Exhibition opens tomorrow Saturday 13 December.

First held in 2005, the Great Southern Noongar Exhibition is an annual exhibition created by artists living in the region. This year's exhibition is entitled *YEY!*, which is the Noongar word for *NOW!*

The exhibition is open to all to artists living in the Great Southern who identify as Noongar, Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander and it is free to enter. It aims to support artists by providing an opportunity to promote and sell their work.

The Vancouver Arts Centre does not retain a commission on any sales of artworks.

The exhibition is curated, and artists can request to enter up to four works. The curators aim to hang all works entered, but reserve the right to limit their selection.

Many contributing artists in this year's exhibition are supported and represented by Mungart Boodja Art Centre.

The exhibition runs from Saturday 13 December to Saturday 24 January 2015.
