Rio Tinto Agreement with City

The City of Albany signed an agreement with Rio Tinto on Monday 9 November for a Trainee Youth Development Officer position to be created at the City of Albany, following a successful partnership for Anzac Albany.

The City of Albany Mayor, Dennis Wellington said the position will be a 12 month traineeship targeting an Albany school leaver planning on taking a gap year before heading to university.

“The trainee will complete a Certificate III in Community Development or similar and work closely with the Senior Community Development Officer on a number of projects including, developing and assisting to coordinate activities during National Youth Week.

“This is a great employment opportunity for a young person, but also provides the opportunity for the City of Albany to increase engagement and development of activities and programmes aimed at young people within the City of Albany.

“Rio Tinto currently has 175 employees living in Albany and this agreement provides them with an opportunity to support employment opportunities for young people and to increase awareness of Rio Tinto’s support of the Albany Community,” said the Mayor.
