




## Muttonbird Reserve Improvement Plan Survey

The City of Albany has engaged South Coast Natural Resource Management Inc. to undertake community consultation and site planning for the Muttonbird Reserve Improvement Plan. The scope of this study is to address management of recreation use, environmental conditions, and amenity requirements of the Muttonbird Reserve which is considered as being of a high value to our community. The objective is to set a clear direction and provide a long-term prioritised plan for future management and improvements of amenities. This aims to address ageing and inadequate infrastructure, enable shared use, and reduce the environmental impact of recreation use while meeting the needs and values of our community.

The following survey aims to gather information from community on the types of activities people undertake at Muttonbird Reserve, the level of amenities required, and to capture any community opinions relating to the current condition of the area.
