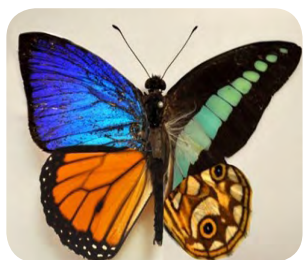

Town Square • 13-18 April

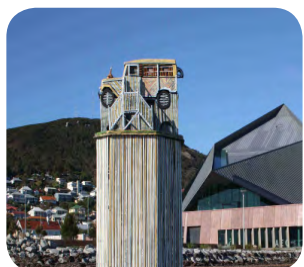
