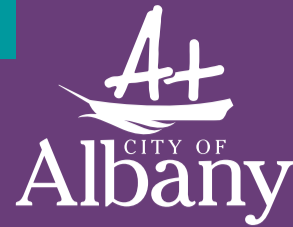

12-25 YRS \$5 per family contribution

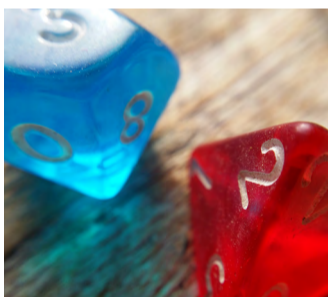


SKATEBOARDING CLINICS
