Organisational Background

Vancouver Arts Centre is an active community arts centre and gallery that is home to many local arts and craft groups and presents an annual program of exhibitions, performing arts events, workshops, and multi-artform community cultural development projects.

The VAC is based in an old historic building (Albany Cottage Hospital), situated 1km from the Albany CBD and is a unique heritage site offering a range of gallery sizes for your exhibition.

VAC Exhibition Program Objectives:

The VAC's exhibition program ensures a diversity of exhibitions are presented to, with and for the community and visitors to the region.

We facilitate community access and participation exhibitions, provide opportunities for local emerging and established artists, support the development of contemporary art practice, curate in response to relevant social and civic themes and present touring exhibitions that may be of interest to our community in a range of ways.

Our Programming Goals for 2019 – 2022 are:

- 1 Telling stories from and about our region: people, place, purpose
- 2 Reflecting on national and global context: people, place and purpose
- 3 Development of local independent creative practice and production
- 4 Intercultural and intergenerational exchange and participation

Eligibility

Applications will be accepted from the following:

- · Artists at any stage of career
- Community groups
- Curators of a group exhibition
- Local, national and international artists

We encourage graduate students, emerging artists, artists who identify as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander, and artists with disability to apply.

Our Offer to Artists

- We will support four exhibitions per year.
- We will provide \$2,000 towards exhibition costs, which can assist with artist labour, materials, transport, installation costs, administration, presentation costs and any ancillary costs related to the opening event.
- Guaranteed minimum exhibition duration of three weeks.

In addition we offer:

- Fully staffed gallery, so no requirement for the artist to sit the exhibition
- Free use of plinths, and installation tools and equipment.
- Polished timber floors
- Professional hanging system
- Ceiling mounted lighting system
- Access to wi-fi
- Connection with the VAC community; up to 15 community groups regularly use the Vancouver Arts Centre, including the Albany Weavers, Albany Floral Art Group, Ace Camera Club, Albany Potters, and Porcelain Painting Friends.
- Contacts with cultural and service organisations in Albany, including the Museum of the Great Southern, the City of Albany Library, and Open Access Youth Arts Studio, as well as creative organisations such as Southern Edge Arts.
- Access to Vancouver Arts Centre facilities and resources and hire of PA systems, projection and film equipment.

- Artwork sales handling (please note a commission rate of 25% plus GST will be applicable for this service if requested).
- Electronic invitation mail out to approximately 1300 newsletter subscribers
- Social media marketing, inclusion in the monthly newsletter and in the regular column in the Great Southern Weekender.
- Promotion of any artist talks, or community workshops that you wish to run in conjunction with your exhibition. (Please note workshop participant fees are to be handled by the artist directly, with the arts centre providing support in promotion and handling community enquiries only.)

Criteria for Selection

Exhibition applications that contribute to achieving our programming goals will be given preference. Applications will also be assessed against the following criteria:

- Artistic excellence the extent to which the artist's work is recognised as of a high calibre. (30%)
- Originality the extent to which the exhibition proposal is unique and innovative. (30%)
- **Timeliness** in terms of the artist's career (is this a great opportunity with high impact for them at this stage?) (20%)
- Value and interest to the local community collaboration with user groups, community engagement, captivating for disinclined audiences, response to local themes or social issues, potential for building or establishing partnerships with other organisations (20%)

How to Apply

Artists are required to provide the following:

- · A completed application form;
- A curriculum vitae;
- Relevant references;
- Documentation of past work (at least 5 examples), whether photo files or slides, photographs, audio files or DVD's of work – (preferably shared via a cloud based platform such as dropbox, vimeo etc).

Applications will be open from December to Mid-February 2019.
