Reminder – free cat registration, cat sterilisation rebate available

The City of Albany is reminding pensioners and low income earners of generous measures it has introduced to help combat the fees associated with cat sterilisation and registration.

From November 1 the State Government will require all cats to be sterilised and microchipped before they can be registered, and has also increased the cost of registration.

To help offset those costs, the City has offered pensioners and low income earners a subsidy of 25 per cent of the cost of cat sterilisation, and free three year cat registration to people who take up that offer.

Conditions apply so for more information or to check if you are eligible please call 9841 9333.

Fines apply for non-compliance with the new laws. Non-sterilised cats will not be able to be registered after November 1.
