Anzac Interpretive Centre works begin

The future site of the Anzac Interpretive Centre will be a hive of activity for the next four weeks as work on the long-awaited project begins.

The centre will be built adjacent to the Submariners Memorial in the Princess Royal Fortress precinct, with construction due to begin in earnest in November.

Before then, forward works to prepare the site are needed, which will include clearing a small area of bush and some minor prescribed burn-offs when weather permits. Work is due to begin this Monday September 16 and will continue for approximately one month.

Albany Mayor Dennis Wellington assured the community the impact on native bushland would be minimal.

Mr Wellington said access to the Forts would be unaffected during these works, however some redirection of walking trails might be required.

Albany contractor Tricoast Civil has been awarded the contract to carry out the forward works.

The Anzac Interpretive Centre project is being overseen by the Anzac Centre Implementation Committee.

The Chair of the Committee, Richard Muirhead, said the Centre was well on track to be built by August 2014.
