ABORIGINAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

Introduction:

The City of Albany is proud to announce the availability of four (4) annual Aboriginal Education Scholarships commencing in January each year, with the aim of encouraging young Aboriginal people to continue with their education and training.

The City of Albany has a long-standing involvement with the local Aboriginal community and supports initiatives designed to create or enhance employment and educational opportunities for Aboriginal people within the community.

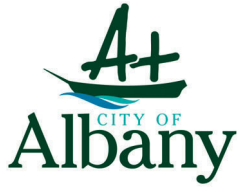
In accordance with the commitment made within the City of Albany Aboriginal Accord, the City of Albany has developed this Aboriginal Education Scholarship Scheme and is now seeking applications for the scholarships from local Aboriginal people requiring assistance to progress their studies or training.

Scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be made available over the following two years to each of four (4) successful applicants, with the scholarship funds being used to offset the cost of books, fees and other student costs at TAFE, University and High School campuses.

Guidelines for Nominations:

1. Applicants must be aged from 15 – 20 years (inc) as at 1st January next
2. Applicants can only receive a scholarship once.
3. A copy of the applicant's last school or equivalent report must be attached to the application.
4. All questions on the application form must be answered fully.
5. Decisions made by the Scholarship Panel are final and no further correspondence shall be entered into.
6. Where appropriate, the City of Albany will pay the scholarship to the educational institution.
7. The scholarship is for a 2-year period i.e. 50% (\$500) of the scholarship each year.

8. All scholarship funds must be allocated to assist the student's education.
9. Aboriginality is a pre-requisite of application.
10. Applicants must normally reside within the City of Albany.
11. The application must be received no later than 31st December, each year, with the scholarships to be awarded for the following 2 years.
