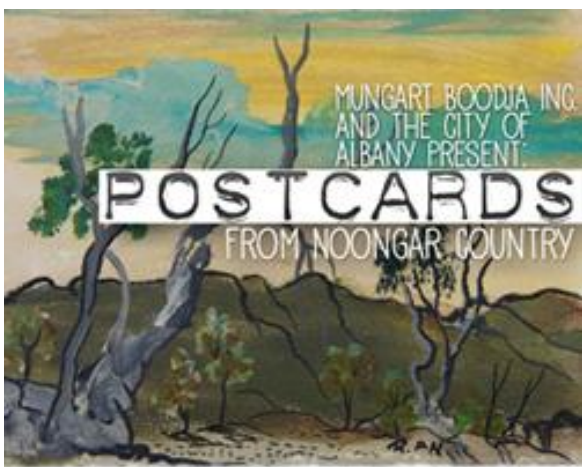
Anne Johnson has created some more exciting workshops for the July school holidays.
