City sets incentives for dog registrations

The City of Albany is offering half price dog registration until 31 October 2013.*

This initiative is to encourage Albany residents to be responsible dog owners and register their dogs.

Registering your dog is simple and can be done at the City of Albany's administration building, 102 North Road, Yakamia. A dog registration application form can be found on the City's website, www.albany.wa.gov.au or can be filled in when you come in to pay the registration fee. If your dog is sterilised and/or micro-chipped, please bring along proof of supporting documentation, when registering.

Registration fees:

Sterilised dogs: \$10 for one year (\$5 with discount)

Unsterilised dogs: \$30 for one year (\$15 with discount)

Upon receipt you will receive a registration tag that is to be placed on your dog's collar. Registering your dog and placing identification on its collar will assist the rangers in returning your dog if lost, injured or involved in an incident.

Under the *Dog Act 1976* all dogs over the age of three months must be registered.

**this applies to one year registration only.*
