Last chance to be involved in Albany bike revolution

A plan which could remodel Albany as the country's most cycle-friendly city will come under discussion at a public forum this coming Monday.

The City of Albany Bike Plan has already received a great deal of interest from local bicycle user groups in recent weeks because of its lofty aim – to transform Albany into Australia's premier cycling destination.

The City has been working closely with key stakeholders on the plan and has also been gathering ideas and input via an "Open Slate" survey, which is still available at https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/Bike_Plan.

This Monday October 21 a public workshop will be held at the City of Albany Civic Rooms on North Road starting at 6pm, with all interested community members invited to attend.

Present will be City staff and representatives from Cardno, a highly regarded transport infrastructure company which has been engaged by the City to develop the plan.

The draft bike plan is expected to be completed by December this year.

The final plan would be subject to further community consultation and Albany City Council approval. The Open Slate Survey is also available in hard copy at the City of Albany North Road office, Albany Public Library, Albany Leisure and Aquatic Centre, and through Albany cycle groups. It ends on October 22.
