To celebrate National Youth Week, a Disco Pool Party will be held at Albany Leisure and Aquatic Centre next Saturday April 12 from 5:30-8:00pm.

Catering for young people aged 10-17, the disco will include a DJ, waterslide, disco ball and water challenges.

Albany Youth Advisory Council member Benedict Gilet said the Disco Pool Party would be a fun way for young people to escape their normal routine.

"It's not just a disco, you get the opportunity to have fun in the pool, float around, listen to good music and challenge your mates to water challenges, rather than just sitting at home on a Saturday night," he said.
