Albany Anzac Day Dawn Service to go ahead after fire, all walk trails off-limits

Tomorrow's Anzac Day Dawn Service will proceed as planned following a fire on Mt Clarence which started yesterday afternoon.

The fire was responded to by DFES career and volunteer firefighters; supported by City of Albany personnel and aerial water bombers.

The Dawn Service will go ahead, however all walk trails leading to the Desert Mounted Corp Memorial will be off limits for safety reasons.

Buses are available from 3:30am from Albany Entertainment Centre and Middleton Beach. Apex Drive will be closed to private vehicles.

A City of Albany heavy fire tanker will be on stand-by at the top of Mt Clarence tomorrow to respond in the unlikely event of an emergency.

Albany Mayor Dennis Wellington thanked emergency crews for their swift and professional response to the fire.
