Emu Point dual-use path adjustment

The City of Albany advises works have commenced on joining two sections of the Middleton Beach to Emu Point dual-use bicycle/walk path.

Currently the path splits at Griffiths Street, with users obliged to walk on the low traffic cul-de-sac for about 200m to reach the next section of path.

Work is taking place to clear a new path through the scrub and link the two sections in readiness for earthworks to commence.

City Works and Services Executive Director Matthew Thomson said project was being conducted to increase safety for users of the path and to complete an important priority link.

The City sought Department of Transport funding for the project. The new section of path is expected to be complete in mid-June.
