

OVERVIEW

The Jetty Link will create a new accessible pathway to the Ellen Cove Jetty at Middleton Beach, Albany.



The project has been made possible with WA State Government funding received through Development WA as a continuation of the Middleton Beach Foreshore Enhancement Project.

The new path connects the foreshore promenade to the Jetty and will be constructed using local granite retaining walls, natural site boulders, and framed decking built around existing trees and large boulders to create new lookouts and interpretive features. Parkland style post and rail fencing is proposed along the boardwalk path to create a safety barrier and protect the revegetation of the bank.

Interpretive artworks will be derived from a collaborative process involving local artists, artisans and community members, including a continuation of the popular reinterpretation of the Robert Neill fish illustration series, featuring Menang Noongar language, which was delivered in the first stage of the foreshore enhancement along the beach promenade.

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






