What's happening

As part of the City of Albany's capital works program, streetscape and roadwork construction will be undertaken to improve safety and upgrade the paths on Stirling Terrace between York Street and Spencer Street.

Background

The City of Albany undertook roadworks and streetscaping on Stirling Terrace, between the Centrelink carpark and Six Degrees, prior to the Centenary Commemorations in 2014.

2020/2021 Construction works

The remainder of the works between York Street and Spencer Street is now scheduled over the next two financial years.



These works will continue the paving, kerbing and parking along Stirling Terrace which will improve safety and connectivity for pedestrians.

The preliminary timing is as follows:

- November / December 2020 – Spencer Street to Six Degrees.
- January / February 2021 – Spencer Street / Stirling Terrace intersection.
- September / October 2021 - Centrelink carpark to York Street.

The City is currently working through the detailed planning and scheduling of works and traffic management. Further information will be communicated prior to works commencing.
