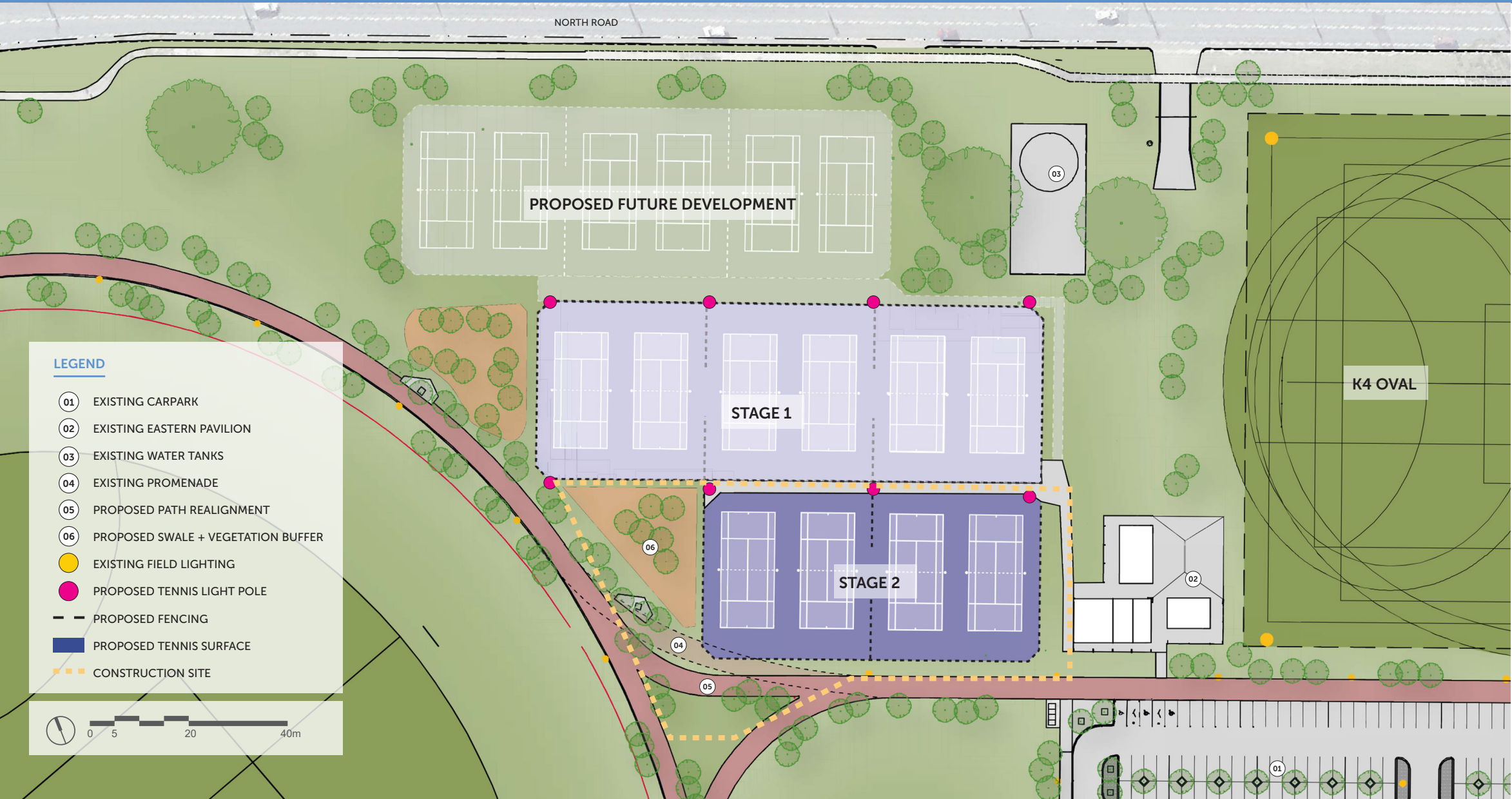


ALBANY REGIONAL TENNIS CENTRE - STAGE 2

EASTERN PRECINCT CENTENNIAL PARK, ALBANY WA



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The overarching purpose of the project is to develop a 16-court regional tennis centre, as a multi-stage project in the Eastern Precinct of the Centennial Park Sporting complex.

Stage 2 will involve the construction of four additional courts, lighting for the six existing courts and path realignment.

Should future funding allow, additional stages will include: flood lighting to the four Stage 2 courts and an additional six tennis courts.

CO-LOCATION OF LOCAL TENNIS CLUBS

As part of the project, Merrifield Park Tennis Club and Lawley Park Tennis Club have amalgamated to form the Albany Tennis Club. (South Coast Tennis Club and Emu Point Sporting Club (tennis segment) also make regular use of the facility.

The benefits of the amalgamation include:

- Increased memberships and social opportunities
- Greater opportunities to evolve the club through existing volunteers
- Greater financial capabilities
- More effective planning and maintenance of courts and facilities
- Reduced volunteer burden.

OBJECTIVES + OUTCOMES

- Increased participation in tennis with new state and national event opportunities. Indicators suggest a minimum immediate 151% increase in facility usage over current Tennis Club facilities. Increasing participation and active, healthy lifestyles with positive mental health outcomes.
- Allow Albany to host major junior and senior tournaments and events.
- Encouraging social and sporting club growth.
- Complement and build on the recently completed and well-developed sporting infrastructure throughout the Centennial Park Precinct.

PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

- The Albany Tennis Club will be operating from both Lawley Park and the new site at Centennial Park until at least 10 courts are constructed at the new Tennis Centre. The lease to Lawley Park will then be surrendered back to the City.
- Lighting to courts will enable Albany Tennis Club will allow public court hire in the evenings. This will further the Club's ability to raise revenue.

PROJECT STATUS

Construction of Stage 1 was completed and officially opened in January 2025. Stage 2, involving the construction of four additional courts and lighting for six courts, has been approved and construction is underway.

Future works, subject to additional funding, include installation of the remaining lights for the four Stage 2 courts, along with the design and construction of the remaining six courts.
