- A regional hub for education, training and work

Pillar: LEADERSHIP

Outcome: A well-governed city with visionary leadership and strong trusted partnerships, that uses resources wisely to meet local needs.

Strategic Priorities:

- Community-focused, values-led Council
- Optimised asset and financial management with planned capital improvements
- Community and organisational emergency readiness
- A well informed and engaged community

Pillar: INFRASTRUCTURE

Outcome: A vibrant city with attractive and connected spaces, supported by forward thinking and responsible planning and development.
