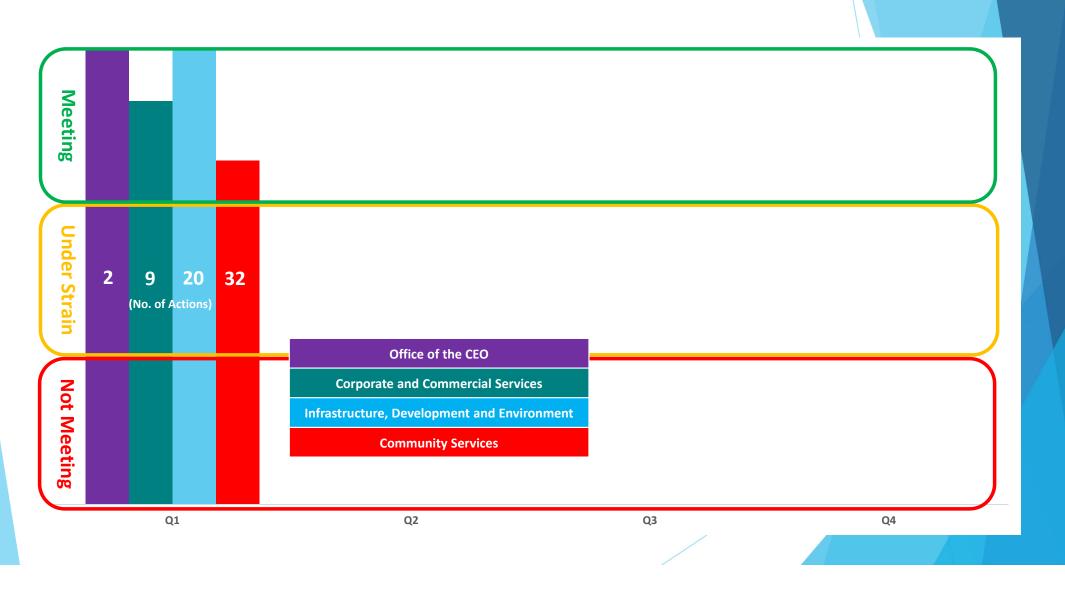




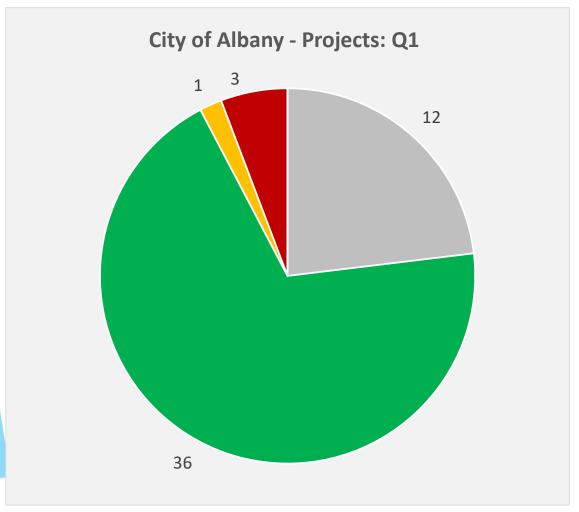
City of Albany 2021/22: All Current Actions* (by Pillar)



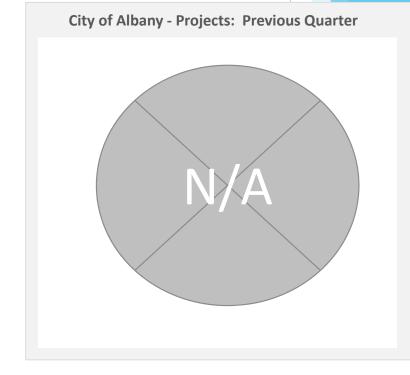
City of Albany 2021/22: Services (by Directorate)



City of Albany 2021/22: Projects (Total)



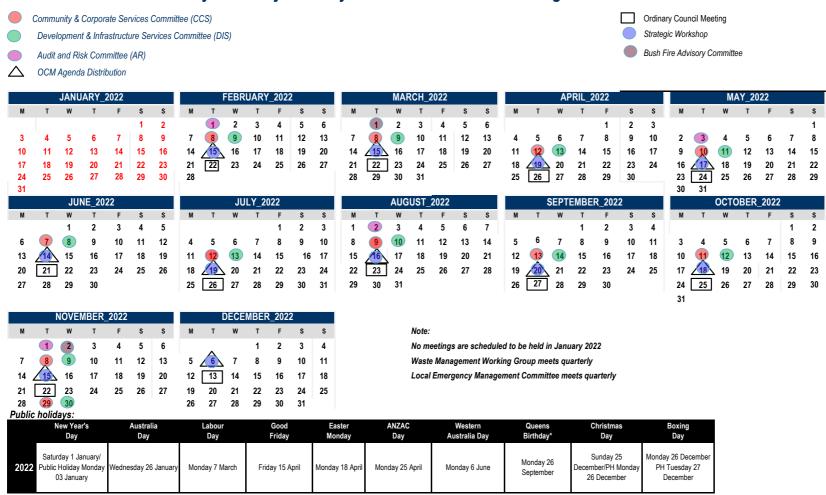
