BASIS OF PREPARATION

**BASIS OF PREPARATION**

The City has reclassified a small number of accounts for comparative purposes. The impact of these reclassifications are considered minor and immaterial and have been made to improve the reporting alignment of the monthly financial report and the annual financial statements.

**REPORT PURPOSE**

This report is prepared to meet the requirements of *Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996, Regulation 34 and 35*. Note: The statements and accompanying notes are prepared based on all transactions recorded at the time of preparation and may vary due to transactions being processed for the reporting period after the date of preparation.

**BASIS OF ACCOUNTING**

This statement comprises a special purpose financial report which has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards (as they apply to local governments and not-for-profit entities) and Interpretations of the Australian Accounting Standards Board, and the *Local Government Act 1995* and accompanying regulations.

The *Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996* take precedence over Australian Accounting Standards. Regulation 16 prohibits a local government from recognising as assets Crown land that is a public thoroughfare, such as land under roads, and land not owned by but under the control or management of the local government, unless it is a golf course, showground, racecourse or recreational facility of State or regional significance. Consequently, some assets, including land under roads acquired on or after 1 July 2008, have not been recognised in this financial report. This is not in accordance with the requirements of *AASB 1051 Land Under Roads paragraph 15* and *AASB 116 Property, Plant and Equipment paragraph 7*.

Accounting policies which have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report have been consistently applied unless stated otherwise. Except for cash flow and rate setting information, the report has been prepared on the accrual basis and is based on historical costs, modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and liabilities.

**PREPARATION TIMING AND REVIEW**

Date prepared: All known transactions up to 30 September 2023

**SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICES**

**CRITICAL ACCOUNTING ESTIMATES**

The preparation of a financial report in conformity with Australian Accounting Standards requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that effect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances; the results of which form the basis of making the judgements about carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REPORTING ENTITY**

All funds through which the City controls resources to carry on its functions have been included in the financial statements forming part of this financial report.

In the process of reporting on the local government as a single unit, all transactions and balances between those funds (for example, loans and transfers between funds) have been eliminated.

All monies held in the Trust Fund are excluded from the financial statements.

**GOODS AND SERVICES TAX**

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with receivables or payables in the statement of financial position. Cash flows are presented on a gross basis. The GST components of cash flows arising from investing or financing activities which are recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO are presented as operating cash flows.

**ROUNDING OFF FIGURES**

All figures shown in this statement are rounded to the nearest dollar.

## Elected Member Meet & Greet Guidelines

### Purpose

This guideline has been developed to provide a framework for meet-and-greet events and activities for elected members to engage with the broader community.

### Scope

This guideline applies to activities and events specifically aimed at building relationships between elected members and the broader community.

This guideline does not apply to community engagement activities that are designed to collect feedback from the community on projects, Strategies or Plan development.

### Objectives:

Council Meet and Greets are held to:

- Build relationships between elected members and the broader community.
- Provide an informal engagement opportunity that aims to be more welcoming to diverse groups not seen in formal engagement (for example, people living with a disability, families, migrants/refugees with English as their second language) in less formal locations including parks and community halls.

### Frequency

- A minimum of two meet and greet type activities to be held each year.
- Frequency of the activities will be driven by requests from the community or align with strategic outcomes for the City.

### Format

- Focus is to be on open dialogue, building relationships between elected members and the wider community over a shared meal (ie BBQ, afternoon tea etc).

- Administration staff to be on hand to record concerns and take down questions so that they can be addressed by the teams responsible. Feedback can then be provided to the attendee post the event, and progress on actions tracked by the Executive Management Team.
- Elected members to act as 'hosts' by:
  - Welcoming each attendee.
  - Introducing them to other elected members, executive staff, and encouraging them to talk to other attendees.
  - Encouraging them to share their feedback and ensuring administration staff have recorded their details and concerns.
  - Depending on the type of activity, Councillors may also act as table 'host' and record concerns/issues raised.
- Mayor/appointed delegate to welcome attendees and thank them for attending. Direct attendees to staff for the recording of any concerns.
- Meet and greets may include:
  - Presentations from community groups.
  - Activities for children.

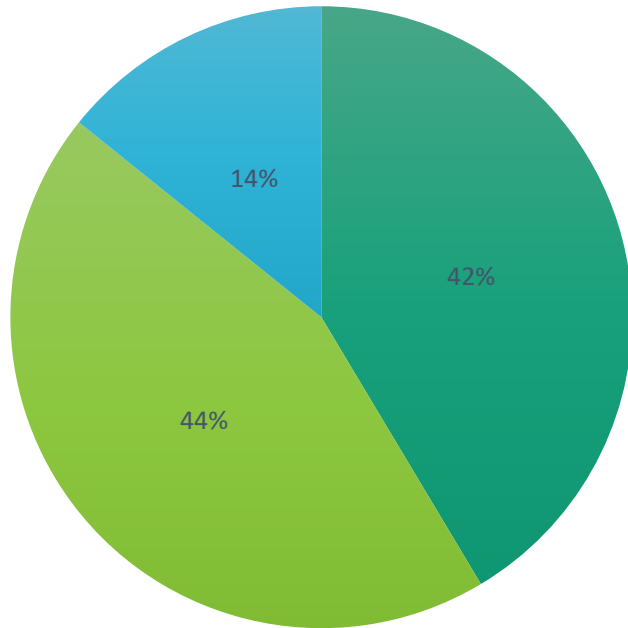

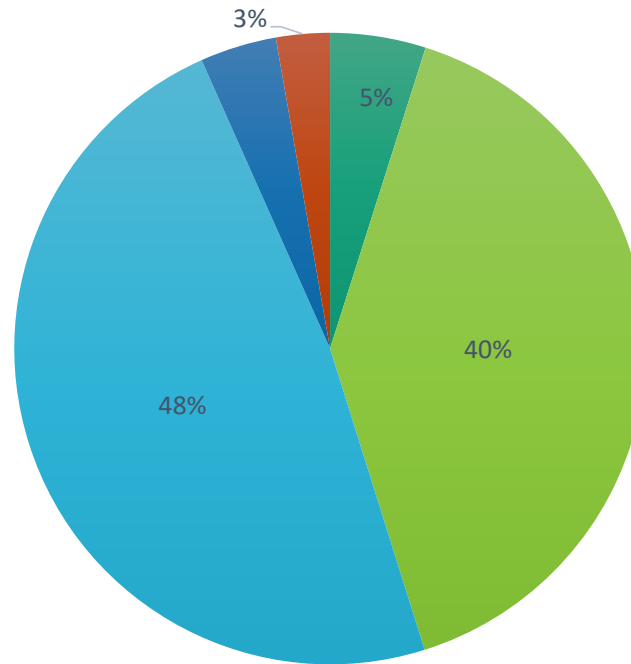
NATIONAL ANZAC CENTRE VISITATION Q1

Jul – Sep 2023



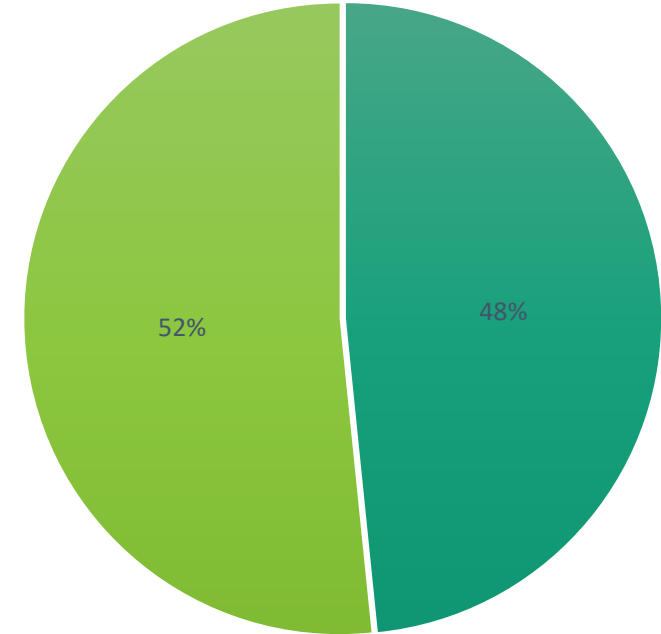

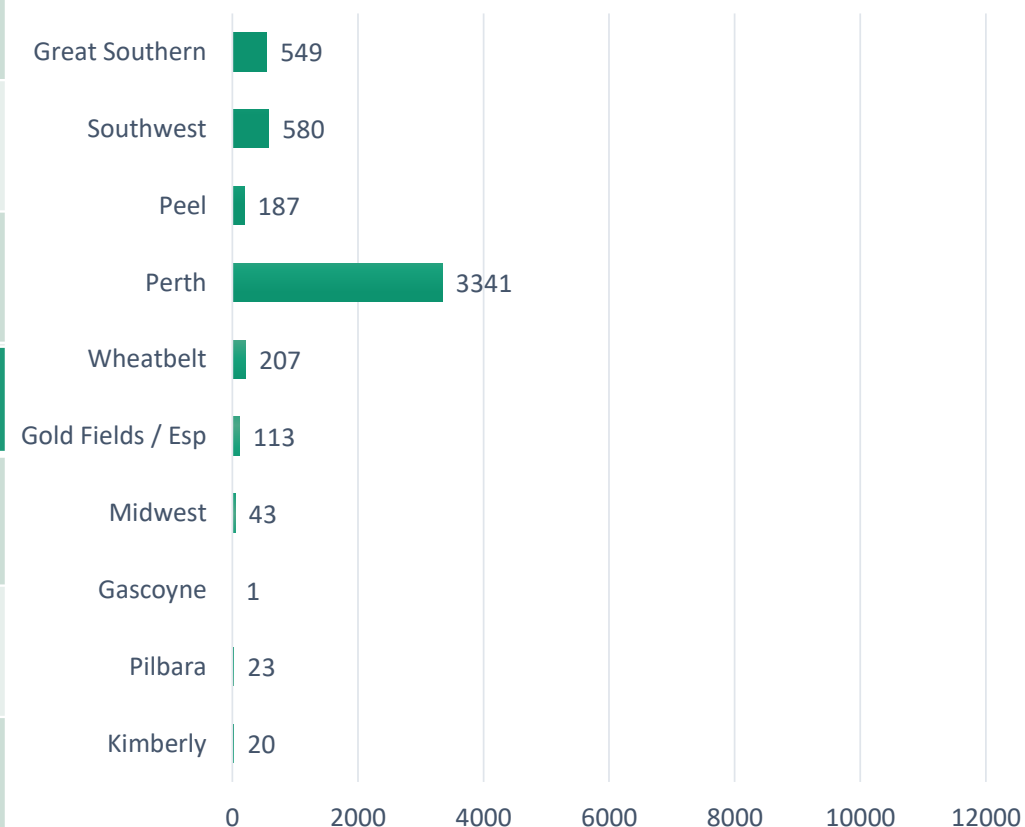

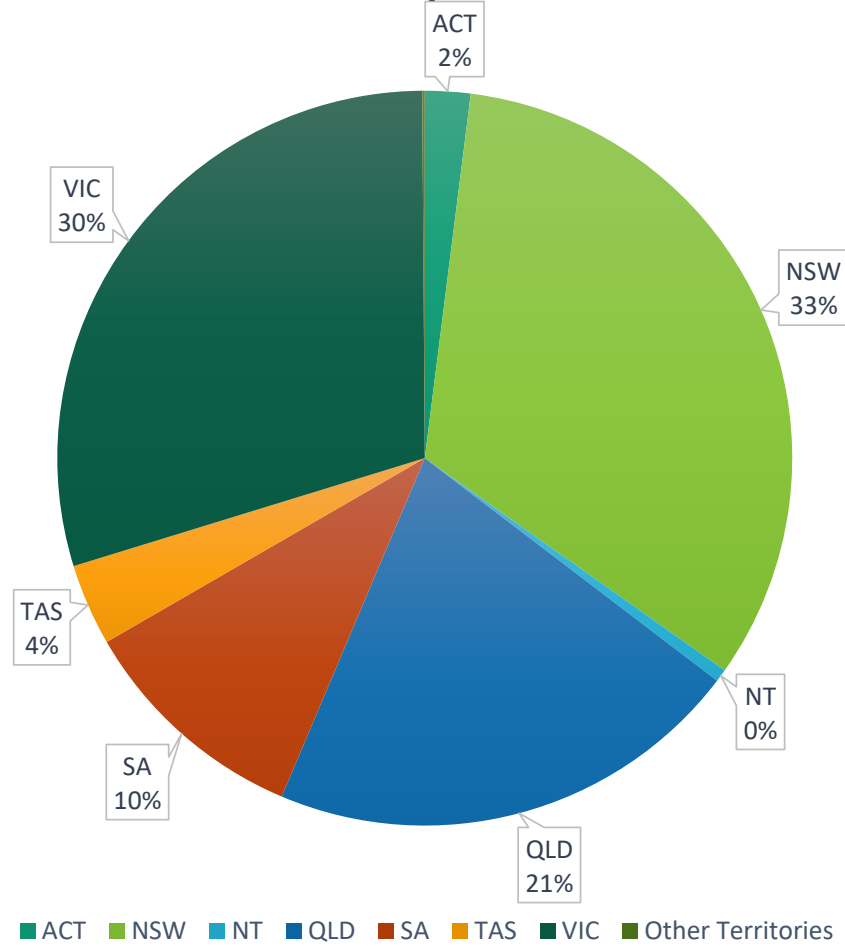

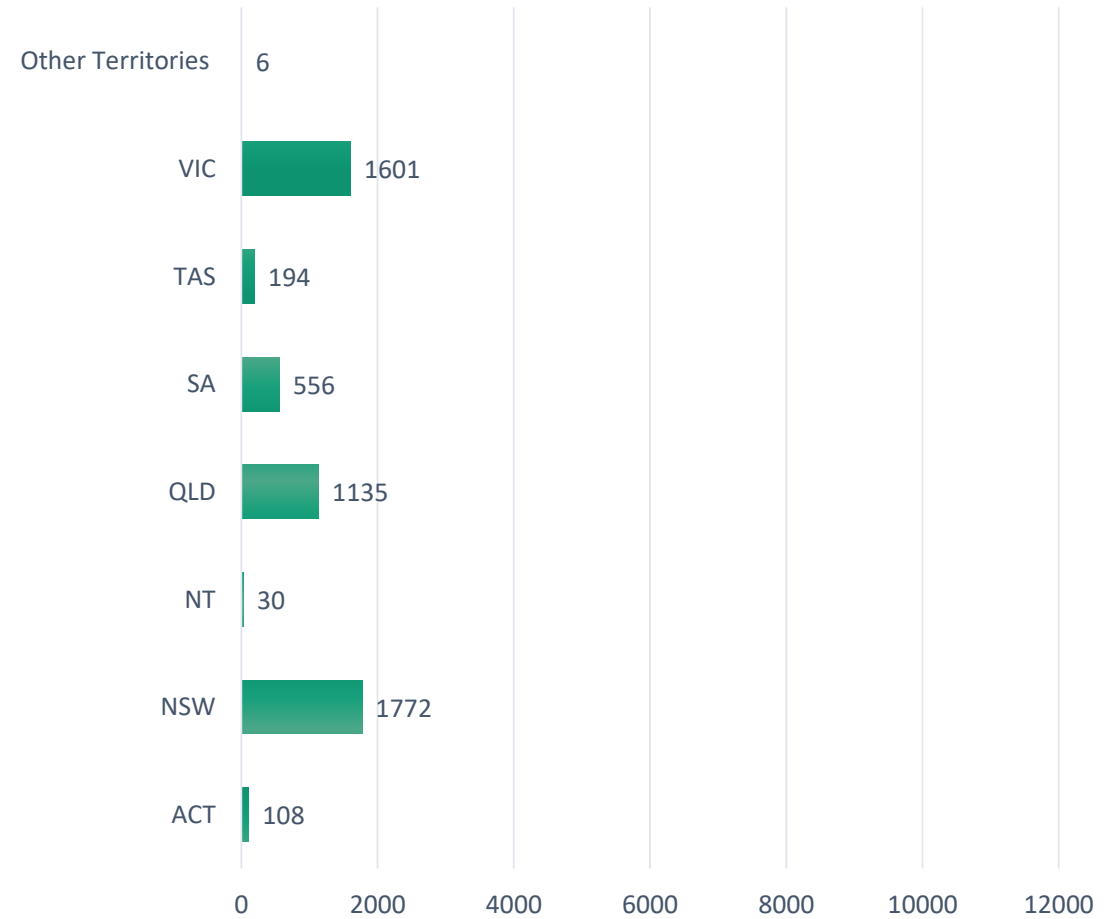

Jul - Sep 2023



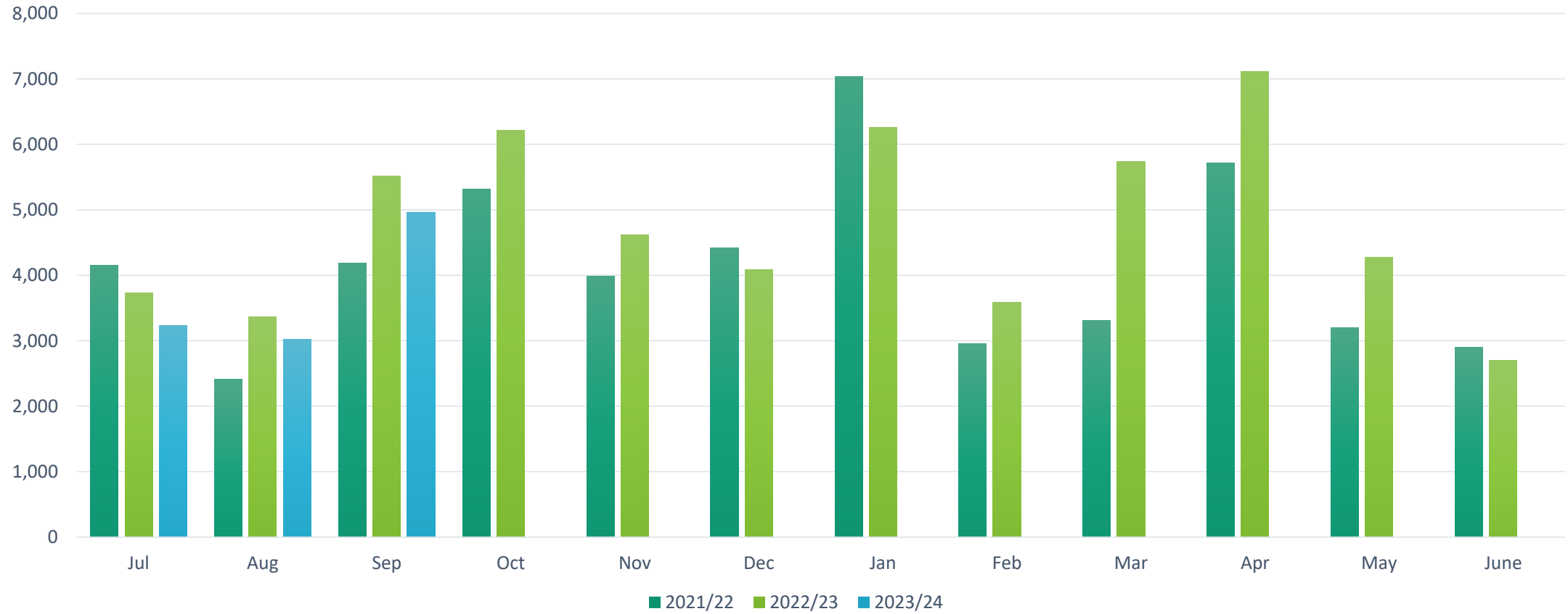

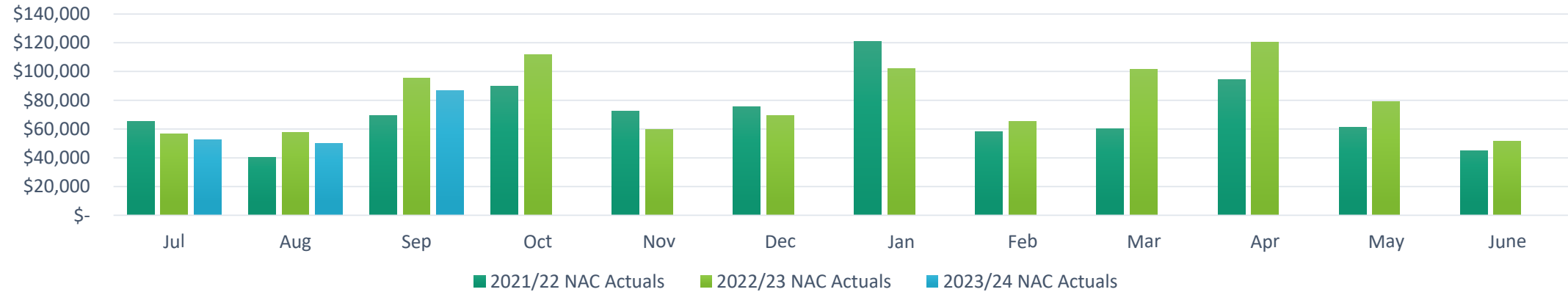
## Visitation - Financial Year Comparisons 2021/22 - 2023/24



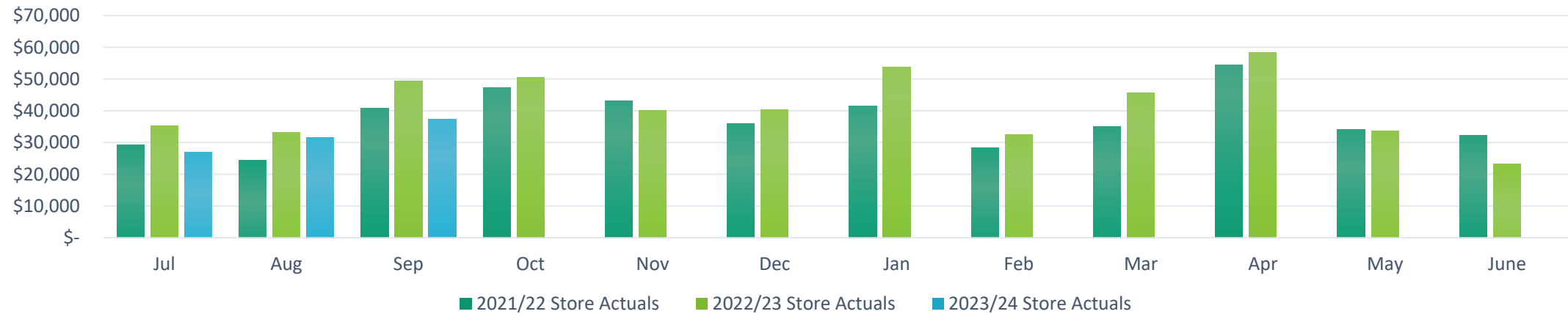
### NAC / Store % of Total Q1

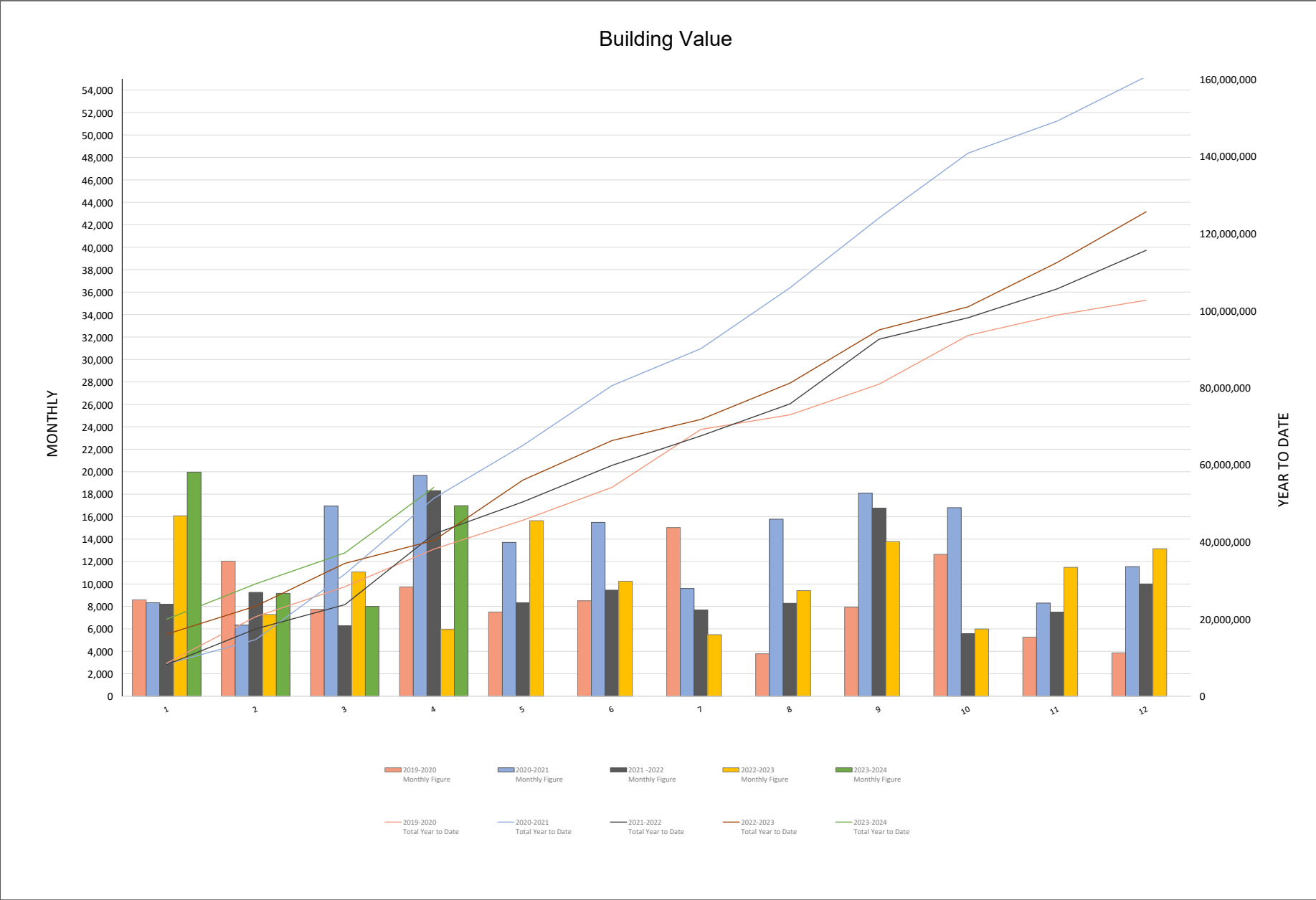

With the rain and flooding recently some of the roads were open to light vehicles only. Crews are prepared and sand bags are ready.

Diarmuid Kinsella

Nothing of significance to report from my end this quarter.

Business as usual for this time of year.

Rob Lynn

Winter Outlook Normal fire potential with rain forecast to below the long term median level (greater than 80% chance) and temperatures are likely to be above median (greater than 60% chance).

Current capability

Normal for this time of year - some brigades have members away and/or involved with agricultural activities.

Future Capacity

Unchanged – new recruits matching retirements.

Emerging Risks

The impact of the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2021 is currently undetermined however may require some revision of planned burning procedures.

Training Exercises

Pre-season regional and local exercises are in the planning phase.

Community Preparedness

Several below average fire seasons have resulted in some community apathy.

AFDRS information and more extensive signage will assist.  
Brigades have appointed Community Engagement Officers who will facilitate formation of Bushfire Ready Groups and be the contact point for local area interaction.  
Pre season community events are being planned by CoA (CESM), DFES and Brigades.

Joel Colgate

We are pleased to say that our staffing levels have started to improve with more capacity to meet client needs, in almost all instances clients have been receiving their scheduled visits as normal both essential and non-essential.

We have commenced a program to recruit for volunteers in the region to support clients with additional services beyond their regular service funding. This could be extra social support to reduce isolation or assistance with accessing internet services for additional security/ support if normal services reduce or become unavailable.

We have now opened up to take on new clients in Mt Barker and many suburbs of Albany, Denmark remains open to new clients also.

We anticipate with flu season there may be an impact on staff (care delivery capacity) and clients themselves. As we work in a very vulnerable cohort we continue to maintain many of the measures implemented during COVID.

Trudi Smits

Southern Ports is planning for an open day at the port for 2024. While it is still early stages it is anticipated two x 2 ½ hours sessions on Saturday 27 April 2024.

Kriss Logan

We are presently without an offshore capable patrol vessel locally. Our is now undergoing a refit until mid Oct.
