**VOTING REQUIREMENT: SIMPLE MAJORITY** 

THAT Council remove the following point from the Committee Recommendation:

"4. The development shall be constructed of materials which blend with the natural landscape. Please note that unpainted zincalume, white and off white colours are not permitted."

## **Councillors Reason:**

The property on which the piggery (breeder) is planned to be established, and the surrounding properties, are in a rural area. Zincalume sheds, in particular, are very much a part of the Australian rural scene and many homes have zincalume roofs. The additional cost to the proponent to use colourbond is quite considerable and would not keep the pigs as cool as zincalume or white cladding to the breeder and other sheds to be constructed.

There does not appear to be any neighbours in any close proximity to the business and should not be affected by the reflection from zincalume structures. Most zincalume loses its main reflectability within a few years.

Within the residential areas of the City, there are a number of houses with roofs of zincalume or white colouring. This does not appear to be prohibited in residential areas so it should be less prohibitive in the much more expansive rural areas.
