

# MARKYT Community Scorecard

The City of Albany commissioned a MARKYT® Community Scorecard to:

- Support a review of the Strategic Community Plan (SCP)
- Assess performance against objectives and key performance indicators (KPIs) in the SCP
- · Determine community priorities
- · Benchmark performance





### The Study

The City of Albany commissioned CATALYSE® to conduct an independent MARKYT® Community Scorecard.

Scorecard invitations were sent to 5,000 randomly selected households; 1,000 by mail and 4,000 by email. The City of Albany provided supporting promotions through its communication channels.








The scorecard was open from 16 February to 10 March 2023 and was completed by **1,359 community members** with various connections to the City.

The main body of this report shows responses from local residents. As responses from the random sample (n=773) and opt-in sample (n=425) were similar, results have been combined in this report. Results from other community groups are reported separately at the end of this report.

Resident responses were weighted by age and gender to match the ABS Census population profile. Where sub-totals add to  $\pm 1\%$  of the parts, this is due to rounding errors to zero decimal places.



# MARKYT Benchmarks | participating councils

CATALYSE® has conducted studies for close to 70 councils. When councils ask comparable questions, we publish the high and average scores to enable participating councils to recognise and learn from the industry leaders. In this report, the average and high scores are calculated from councils that have completed a MARKYT® accredited study within the past three years.








