

ALBANY REGIONAL TENNIS CENTRE - STAGE 1

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The delivery of Albany Regional Tennis Centre will see Merrifield Park Tennis Club and Lawley Park Tennis Club amalgamate to form the Albany Tennis Club.

The overarching purpose of the project is to develop a 16-court regional tennis centre, as a multi-stage project in the Eastern Precinct of the Centennial Park Sporting complex.

Stage 1 will involve the construction of 6 tennis courts and the implementation of a court booking system.

Subject to future funding, additional stages will include: an additional 10 tennis courts (to total 16 courts), flood lighting and extension to the existing shared clubroom facilities.

OBJECTIVES

- Increased participation in tennis with new local and state event opportunities.
- Encouraging social and sporting club growth, develop local community activity.
- Complement and build on sporting infrastructure throughout Centennial Park.

STAGE 1 SCOPE

- Construction of 6 hard courts to International Tennis Federation (ITF) standards.
- A book-a-court system, enabling the community to book courts via a mobile application
- Associated infrastructure including fencing, poles, nets etc.
- Stormwater and drainage works.

TIMING


Works are expected to commence in February 2024 and completed by June 2024
