PERMIT NUMBER

PLEASE NOTE, THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY TO THIS PERMIT:

1. Connection is to be inspected by a City of Albany Officer prior to backfilling.
2. Discharge to the City of Albany's system is to be via a silt trap located within the property.
3. Stormwater is to be attenuated in accordance with the City of Albany's Subdivision and Development Guidelines.
4. Connection is to be completed by a licensed plumber.
5. Dial before you dig must be completed prior to construction.
6. The minimum cover for pipes installed in the verge is 400mm.
7. Minimum connection standard is to be via a 90mm Stormwater Grade PVC pipe.
8. The pipe is to be grouted at connection.
9. The outlet invert is to be no higher than the obvert of the highest pipe discharging into the pit.
10. The verge is to be stabilised after backfill.
11. Any footpaths disturbed must be restored to their original condition.
12. This permit is only valid for a period of 3 months from date of issue.
13. A Traffic Management Plan must be submitted for City approval 14 days prior to works affecting traffic or pedestrians.
14. Where any footpath or pedestrian access area is disturbed, removed or damaged by the works, the applicant must reinstate the asset to the satisfaction of the City of Albany. Reinstatement must match the existing asset where it is serviceable or be upgraded to the current City standard where the existing asset is worn, unsafe or below current standard. Safe, trafficable and accessible pedestrian access must be maintained during construction, including for mobility aid users. Where the existing path cannot remain open, a suitable temporary alternative route with appropriate signage, barriers and traffic/pedestrian management must be provided to the satisfaction of the City.
