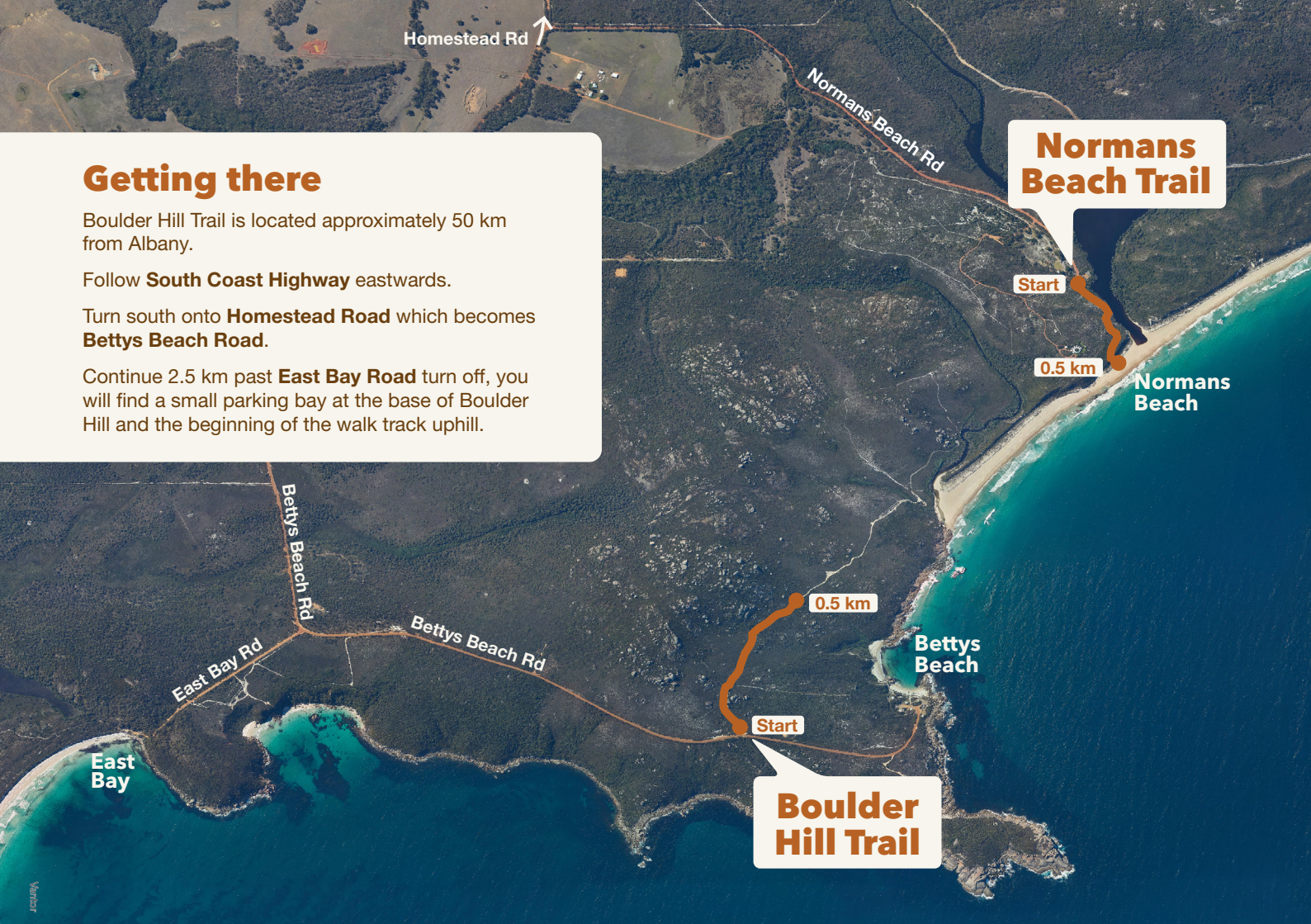
Getting there

Boulder Hill Trail is located approximately 50 km from Albany.

Follow **South Coast Highway** eastwards.

Turn south onto **Homestead Road** which becomes **Bettys Beach Road**.

Continue 2.5 km past **East Bay Road** turn off, you will find a small parking bay at the base of Boulder Hill and the beginning of the walk track uphill.

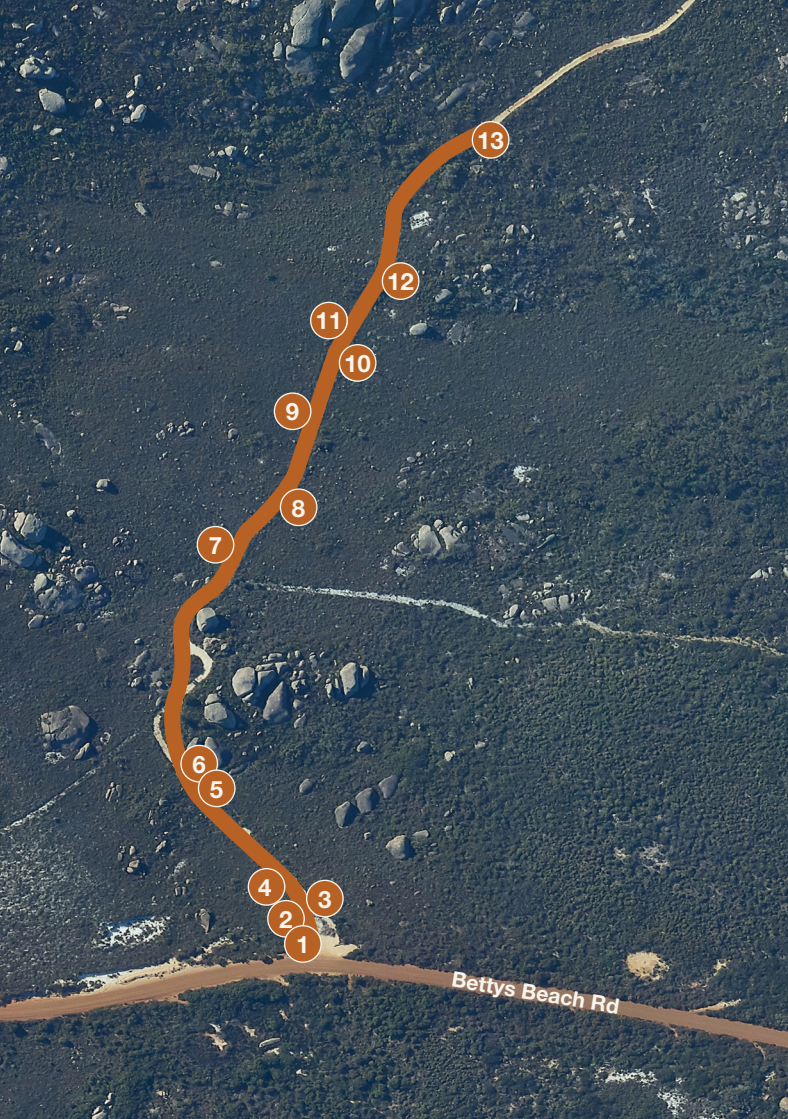

Walking the trail

The wildflower trail is approximately 1 km return, up a sandy hill. The sand track is relatively soft and steep.

Please be mindful of vehicles as 4WDs regularly use this track too.

You can continue beyond the last marked post for another 1 km or so till you reach the creek. It is private property beyond the creek and you will need to turn around.

All flowers are beside the track. Please do not leave the track.

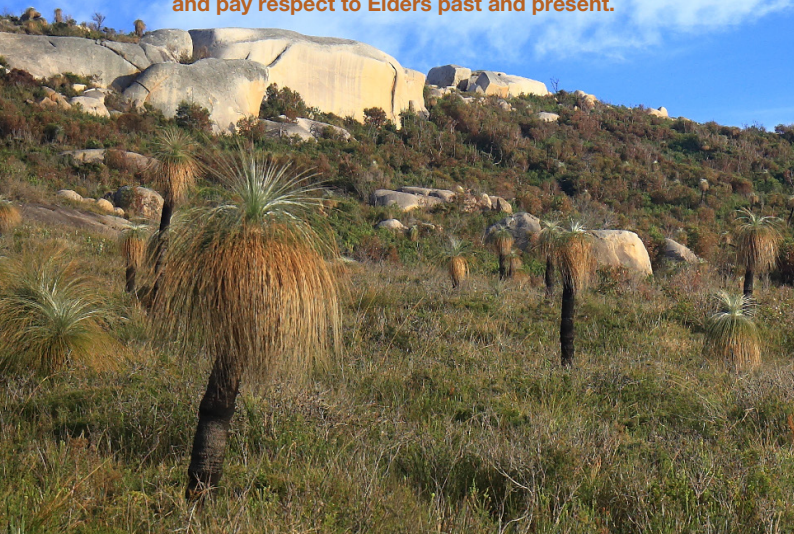
