



BURN PERMIT APPLICATION INTENTION TO BURN

This application does not replace a *Permit to Burn*. Its purpose is to request an inspection by a Fire Control Officer to facilitate the issuing of a *Permit to Burn* (permit to set fire to bush or land) within the City of Albany's, Northeast or Southwest Sector.

Under s18(6) of the Bush Fires Act 1954, a permit in writing must be obtained by a person wishing to set fire to bush or land during the restricted burning time. The conditions contained on the permit must be complied with. Burning without a permit or failing to comply with permit conditions may attract a \$250.00 fine.

Applications should be submitted at least **5 working days** prior to the intended burn date. Permits cannot be issued during a declared Prohibited Burning time.
