

City of Albany Transfer Stations User Guide

Rural Transfer Stations provide a domestic waste service for rural ratepayers. Farm and commercial waste is not accepted at these sites.

Rural Waste Passes

A current Rural Waste Pass or Ute/Trailer Pass must be presented to dispose of waste at transfer stations. **Without a pass you will be directed to the Hanrahan Road or Bakers Junction landfill sites and charges will apply.**

Rural ratepayers receive one Domestic Rural Waste Services Pass each financial year to dispose of domestic waste at any of the City's Rural Transfer Stations, as well as the Hanrahan Road and Bakers Junction landfill sites. Each pass has 52 tokens with each token equal to a 140 litre bin of rubbish.

One pass for a ute/trailer (6x4m) load of waste is also issued each financial year. This pass can only be used once.

Procedure

AT EACH DEPOSIT POINT VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED WITH HANDBRAKE ON & ENGINE OFF

1. On arrival at the transfer station report to the attendant who will check your pass and load. The attendant will punch holes in your card tokens depending on the number of waste bins deposited. Cards will not be punched for any recycling deposited.
2. Deposit **recycling** in the recycle bins provided.
3. Move your vehicle to the general waste area and deposit **waste** in the large skip bin.
4. Deposit **scrap steel** in the steel bins (not available at Wellstead and South Stirling).
NO fencing wire, fencing mesh or commercial quantities of steel permitted in these bins.
5. As you leave the transfer station be aware of other vehicles in the area.
6. Please allow enough time to unload before closing times.

Recycling

All recyclable items accepted in the City's kerbside service can be deposited at transfer stations free of charge. See overleaf for information.

Other Items

DrumMuster: Eligible cleaned agvet chemical containers can be deposited free of charge at Kronkup, South Stirling, Wellstead and Hanrahan Waste Facility.

Motor Oil: Kronkup, Wellstead, Bakers Junction, Hanrahan **Cooking Oil:** Hanrahan

The following items are NOT accepted at transfer stations but can be deposited at Fossicker's Shop at the Hanrahan Waste Facility free of charge:

- **Household Hazardous Waste** including household batteries; chemicals with legible labels (e.g., acids, coolants, cleaners, poisons); fire extinguishers (red only); flammables; fluorescent globes; gas cylinders; paint; smoke detectors
- **Electronic Waste** (e.g., computers, televisions) and **Mobile Phones** (and components)
- **Asbestos** is accepted for disposal at Hanrahan Waste Facility. Charges apply. NOTE: There are essential requirements for wrapping and safety prior to bringing asbestos to landfill. Visit www.albany.wa.gov.au for details.
- **Household items** (e.g., furniture, electronics, clothes, kitchenware, outdoor and sporting equipment) suitable for resale can be taken to Fossicker's Shop at Hanrahan Waste Facility
- **Green waste** can be taken to Vancouver Waste, 21 John Street, Milpara. Charges apply.
