

City of Albany Transfer Station User Guide

Rural Transfer Stations provide a complimentary domestic waste service for rural residents within the City of Albany.

General Waste

Each financial year domestic rural ratepayers receive complementary Rural Residents Waste Passes, including:

- 40 tokens for disposal of a 140 litre bin (or equivalent) of General Waste per token; and
- 1 ute/trailer pass for disposal of larger items, up to 300kg.

A valid Rural Residents Waste Pass must be presented at each visit to any City of Albany Rural Transfer Station. Passes are also accepted at the Bakers Junction and Hanrahan Road Waste Facilities. Additional passes can be purchased from the City of Albany Administration Office on North Road. Information on fees for additional passes is available on the City of Albany website.

Hazardous waste and items that have a fee attached at waste facilities, such as mattresses, asbestos and tyres, are not accepted at transfer stations and passes cannot be redeemed for these products.

Recycling

Household comingled recycling is accepted at Transfer Stations and Waste Facilities at no cost. Keep your recycling simple and remember **only 5 things** go in the recycling bin:

- Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- Cans
- Plastic bottles and containers (lids removed)
- Paper
- Cardboard (flattened)

Items must be **rinsed**, **lids removed**, **and loose** (not in bags). Please **do not** put soft plastics, batteries, hazardous waste, clothing or rope in your recycling bin.



Please note: it is a condition of using your Rural Residents Waste Pass that recycling is separated from General Waste.

Using Transfer Stations

- Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to closing to allow time for unloading.
- Present Pass to Transfer Station attendant on arrival. One token will be redeemed for each 140L waste bin or equivalent amount of General Waste.
- Deposit your household recycling in the recycling bins provided.
- Move your vehicle to the General Waste unloading ramp to deposit your waste into the large skip bin.
- Additional items may be accepted at some facilities please contact the City for further information.

Safety notes

- Please ensure you are able to safely unload your own waste.
- Children and pets should remain in vehicles at all times.
- Be aware of other vehicles moving around the site.
