REDUCE & REFUSE

- ✓ Think before you buy
- ✓ Choose less packaging
- ✓ Say no to single-use straws, coffee cups, plastic bags and cutlery

Plastic bags & soft plastic packaging can be returned to REDcycle points at some supermarkets. Do NOT put it in your household recycling bin.



REUSE & REPAIR

- ✓ Take your own bags shopping
- ✓ Remember your coffee cup
- ✓ Fix the items you have
- ✓ Buy pre-loved

Household Recycling Bin

Loose, clean and empty:

- ✓ Single-use plastic bottles & containers (remove lids)
- ✓ Glass bottles & jars
- ✓ Steel & aluminium cans
- ✓ Milk & juice cartons (NO silver-lined UHT cartons)
- ✓ Magazines & paper (NOT shredded)
- ✓ Cardboard (please flatten)
- ✗ NO plastic bags
- ✗ NO polystyrene
- ✗ NO green waste
- ✗ NO food waste

Green Waste Bin



EMPTIED EVERY FOUR WEEKS



- ✓ Grass clippings
- ✓ Prunings (up to 15cm thick & 75cm long)
- ✓ Weeds & Leaves
- ✗ NO food scraps
- ✗ NO plant pots
- ✗ NO plastic
- ✗ NO nappies
- ✗ NO bricks/rubble
- ✗ NO hot ash

EMPTIED WEEKLY

Household Landfill Waste Bin

Put these in your Household Waste Bin:

- ✓ Non-recyclable items
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Crockery, broken glass
- ✓ Food scraps
- ✗ NO hazardous waste or chemicals
- ✗ NO batteries
- ✗ NO fluorescent light globes
- ✗ NO mobile phones



HAZARDOUS WASTE @ FOSSICKER'S

Household hazardous waste needs to be disposed of carefully to protect humans, animals & our environment. Do NOT put these in your household bins. Take them to Fossicker's instead:

- ✗ Acids, chemicals & cleaning products
